SUPREME COURT ADOPTS COURT INTERPRETER RULE

The Supreme Court of Ohio has adopted a new rule that would require courts to hire a certified foreign language or sign language interpreter, when available, to ensure the "meaningful participation" of deaf and limited English proficient individuals in court proceedings; The rule takes effect on January 1, 2013

HOUSE BILL 153 – Effective 6/11/11

(R.C. 1905.01) - Existing law provides that, except in Georgetown in Brown County, in Mount Gilead in Morrow County, and Batavia in Clermont County, all other municipal corporations must have a population of 100 in order to establish a mayor's court. The bill increases this population requirements to 150.
